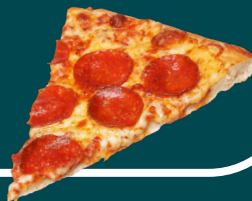

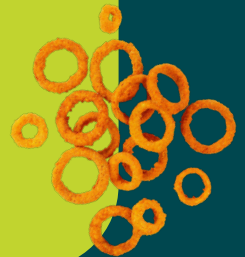

# ETHONAL FACTS

## REGULAR 88

- Ethanol is a renewable, earth-friendly biofuel made from plants that **reduces greenhouse gas and other harmful pollutant emissions.**
- Ethanol has a naturally high octane rating – 113 – and **helps engines run cooler, run longer, and make better horsepower gains.**
- **Nuvu Fuels Regular88 is E15.** E15 is a 15 percent ethanol blended fuel that today can be found at more than 2,680 gas stations across the country.
- Low-carbon biofuels like ethanol **reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 46 percent compared to gasoline.**
- Regular88 is fully approved for use in cars, SUVs, pickups, vans, or other light-duty vehicles that were manufactured after the year 2000. That means **more than 96% of the vehicles on the road today are legally approved to use E15.**
- **Regular88 is the most thoroughly tested fuel in history.** Before approving the fuel in 2011, EPA and the U.S. Department of Energy rigorously tested the use of E15 in 80 vehicles, accumulating more than 6 million miles while operating on the fuel. Scientists carefully analyzed the impact of E15 on drivability, catalyst durability, fuel pumps, seals, diagnostic systems, fuel system components, fuel economy, and exhaust emissions. They definitively concluded that E15 is safe for use in all vehicles built after 2000.
- **Consumers have driven some 55 billion miles on E15 since 2012** without any verified reports of performance issues or engine problems, nor have any warranty claims been made.
- Many variables can impact fuel economy in the real world, a recent study conducted by the University of California showed **some vehicles experienced slightly better fuel economy when using E15 instead of E10.**

## HIGHER LEVEL BLENDS

- Gasoline blended with more than 15 percent or more ethanol is considered a “higher ethanol blend.” **These blends are for use in Flex Fuel Vehicles.**
- **You can check if you have a Flex Fuel Vehicle by checking your gas cap or your owner’s manual.**
- Nuvu Fuels offers E30, E50 and E85.  
**E30 contains 30% ethanol**  
**E50 contains 50% ethanol**  
**E85 contains up to 85% ethanol**
- Pure ethanol contains less BTUs than gasoline, however the cost savings at stations like **NUVU Fuels offset any fuel mileage reduction.**
- **E30 offers the smallest drop in fuel mileage.**
- **E85 offers the lowest cost per mile driven.**
